
High Path Regeneration update



Welcome to the High Path regeneration update. Inside you will find the latest information about the regeneration, the planning applications for future phases and what you can expect over the next few months.

First new homes complete



The first 134 new homes are now complete and residents are moving in. We want to thank everyone for their patience during the construction.

It remains a busy time on High Path as residents have moved into Phoenix Court and Hyacinth Court and others are settling into Triumph House. Leaseholders and freeholders will soon be moving into their new homes in Acorn House, Iris Lodge and Rodney Place. Every one of those homes will be occupied by an existing High Path household. That will also be the case with the next phase, where preparatory works get underway in the next few weeks.

We are planning an event to mark the completion of the first part of the regeneration. All High Path residents and stakeholders are invited to join us and we will write to you with more information closer to the time.

We will be starting early works to prepare the area around Lovell House and Marsh Court over the next few weeks. This work includes the demolition of 10 garages at Lovell House.

In the next phase we will be building 113 new homes for existing tenants and homeowners. Your regeneration manager, Donna Brown, will be contacting residents matched with new homes in phase 2 to confirm your housing needs.

We are continuing to consult with residents and stakeholders on our proposals for Phase 3. We anticipate construction of this phase of the regeneration will begin in 2024 and complete in 2026, subject to planning permission.

Consultation events

Thank you to everyone who attended previous consultation events. Your comments and feedback on the plans are helping to shape the final design of future phases of the regeneration.

We are planning further consultations about Phase 3 and Phases 4-7 in the summer to update you on the progress and for you to give us your feedback, ideas and comments.

The consultation events will take place online and in-person. To join an online event you will need a smart phone, tablet, laptop or desk top computer and access to the internet.

Hayward Close cabling and substation works



You may notice increased activity around Hayward Close while UK Power Networks (UKPN) carry out cabling works in the area. The work is being undertaken to improve the reliability of the electricity network.

Later on in the year, subject to planning permission, we will start work to replace the existing substation in readiness for phase 3 of the regeneration. The substation will serve residents in future phases.
